Field Trip OR Extended Travel

Behavior Requirements

The following expectations for student behavior are presented so you have a clear understanding of how you may best represent yourself and your school while on a field trip/extended travel. Please read the expectations listed below and sign your name where requested. Your signature indicates that you have read and agree to follow these rules while you are on this field trip/extended travel.

1. A student shall not: use any beverage containing alcohol; use tobacco; or use or consume, have in possession, buy, sell, or give away any controlled substance, including alcohol.
2. A student will not violate the sexual harassment policy of District 197 which prohibits unwanted speech or physical contact of a sexual nature.
3. A student may not leave the group individually. Any small group activities must be arranged with a teacher/advisor; a teacher/advisor or chaperone must accompany any sub-group.
4. On overnight trips, students must stay in their assigned hotel room/quarters, and not switch rooms. Further, once bed checks have been completed, students may not leave their assigned quarters.
5. Students may not enter or ride in any unapproved motorized vehicle (car, scooter, motorbike, boat, train). The only approved vehicles are those arranged by a teacher/advisor or vehicles of public transportation.
6. Students are expected to follow the directions of the teacher advisor and chaperones at all times. Disrespectful language or behavior directed toward any of the adults on the trip will not be allowed.
7. Respect for the property of others is expected. Theft, vandalism, and other illegal acts will not be tolerated.
8. This field trip is an extension of the school program and all school rules and regulations, as provided to you, though they may not be included in this listing, will apply.
9. Students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on themselves, their families, their school and their community.
10. Students who disregard any of these requirements may be removed from the group for the duration of the field trip/extended travel and/or be returned home at the expense of the student's parent/guardian.

Parental Permission

If an emergency arises, it might be necessary of seek health care for your child before staff can contact you. Such care can be provided only if you sign the authorization below. Either the authorization or a statement of the reason for not allowing it should accompany this form.
